- 4. At Ersinampalayam, the drinking water filters are available in good condition, but it needs plumbing work. BFI may get a quotation for this work, so that the filter could be make use of the students.
- 5. Soriankinathupalayam library to be established and library in-house project to be implemented like Ersinampalayam
- 6. Competition among students on Tirukural recitation to be considered for annual day and to be discussed with teachers during next visit
- 7. Club activities to be considered, like Maths club science club, arts and crafts club and discussed with teachers during next visit
- 8. Small science projects from Arvindgupta toys site to be shown and started with the schedule and proper follow up to be done.
